Inaugural ceremony of the two-day interdisciplinary international virtual conference on "Life, Culture and Education today" was started at 11:00 am. Initially Principal Dr. V. D. Satpute (LRWC, Sonpeth) welcomed all the patrons, Resourse Persons and Participants on behalf of organizers. Dr. Kalyn Gangarde (MGEWS, Parbhani) stated objectives behind the organization of this virtual conference in his introductory speech.

During inaugural speech professor Gavhane said that human life is affected by Science and technology. Human beings are getting developed and they believe that they are controller of the word. Due to their grid to achieve more they are destroying nature very badly. Hence education is the best tool to introduce culture among the people specially value education must be the part of education system.


gives nice message from which human must learn which will be helpful to analyse culture of the society.

In keynote address Professor K. S. Ramesh delivered speech on 'Reassessment of life culture and education in the context of COVID-19 pandemic'. During his talk Professor Ramesh highlighted on pandemic and its impacts. He also stated that during modernization human has diverted from the nature. Hence there is time to rethink and reassess about relationship with nature, relationship with our traditional knowledge system, relationship with non human and It's time to think how to replenish the earth not just extract form it. Finally Prof. Ramesh told that we must rethink that how science will be free from politics hence it will be more nature friendly and more useful to the human being.

Dr. R. T. Bedre chairperson of the session highlighted on 'Impact of COVID-19 pandemic on the education' during his speech Dr. Bedre stated that during pandemic various educational activities were run which can be mainly categorised into-- COVID-19 awareness quizzes, Online teaching and E-content development and Academic webinars and conferences.

Dr. Bedre said that out of these three, Awareness campaign or quizzes are not reaching to the target groups but these are only run by the institutions as a part of their activities. Same thing is there in case of online teaching and E-content development workshop or FDPs which are done by number of faculties but still there is doubt whether these courses will be counted for their promotion or API. However online webinars or conferences are very good platform to exchange or enhance the knowledge but as its number is increasing there is doubt whether organisation of such activities will meet its objectives or not.





Dr. Mala Pandurang has given lecture on 'Role of arts in pandemic and post pandemic times'. She said that COVID-19 pandemic forced people to be away from each other. Due to physical distancing this pandemic has affected arts (Painting, Dancing, Drama etc.) very badly but now it is representing on virtual mode and getting popularity. Number of artists are now getting popularity using social media and virtual platforms. Artists are also taking part in the awareness campaigns during this pandemic as a social responsibility.

Professor Rajnish Ratna delivered his talk on 'Teaching and Learning in COVID-19: Management education'. During his talk Prof. Rajnish Ratna gave management education data in India. According to him there are 6231 management institutions and there is only 7% employment among the management students this data is before COVID-19 pandemic. During pandemic different factors like Socio-economic condition, Culture and Income has affected the management education in India.

Prof. Hamidur Rahman delivered his talk on 'ELT (English Language Teaching) situation in Bangladesh: Expectation and Realities'. Prof. Rahman told that there are different challenges in ELT at different levels of education system. At primary level there is a lack of skilled and trained teachers and lack of proficiency in English speaking. While at secondary level teachers think that their goal is to teach grammar and help students to get good grades in examination. They do not talk on speaking and listening skills as they are not tested.

At Tertiary level ELT is better as there are qualified teachers but not fully satisfactory. According to Prof. Rahman English is studied from primary to tertiary level in Bangladesh but students cannot speak English fluently and cannot read it properly. Students memorize answers they do not try to speak English inside or outside the classroom. Low paid, untrained teachers are major challenges in the ELT in Bangladesh. During this session Introduction of Dignitaries was given by Dr P. V. Barkale, Dr. Bharat Gugane, Satwa Kamble & V. S. Dhanve While Dr. D. D. Kamble expressed vote of thanks.




Chairperson of this session Dr. Arbind Kumar Choudhary said that tolerance and satisfaction are the most important part of the life tolerance is bridge between two societies more
