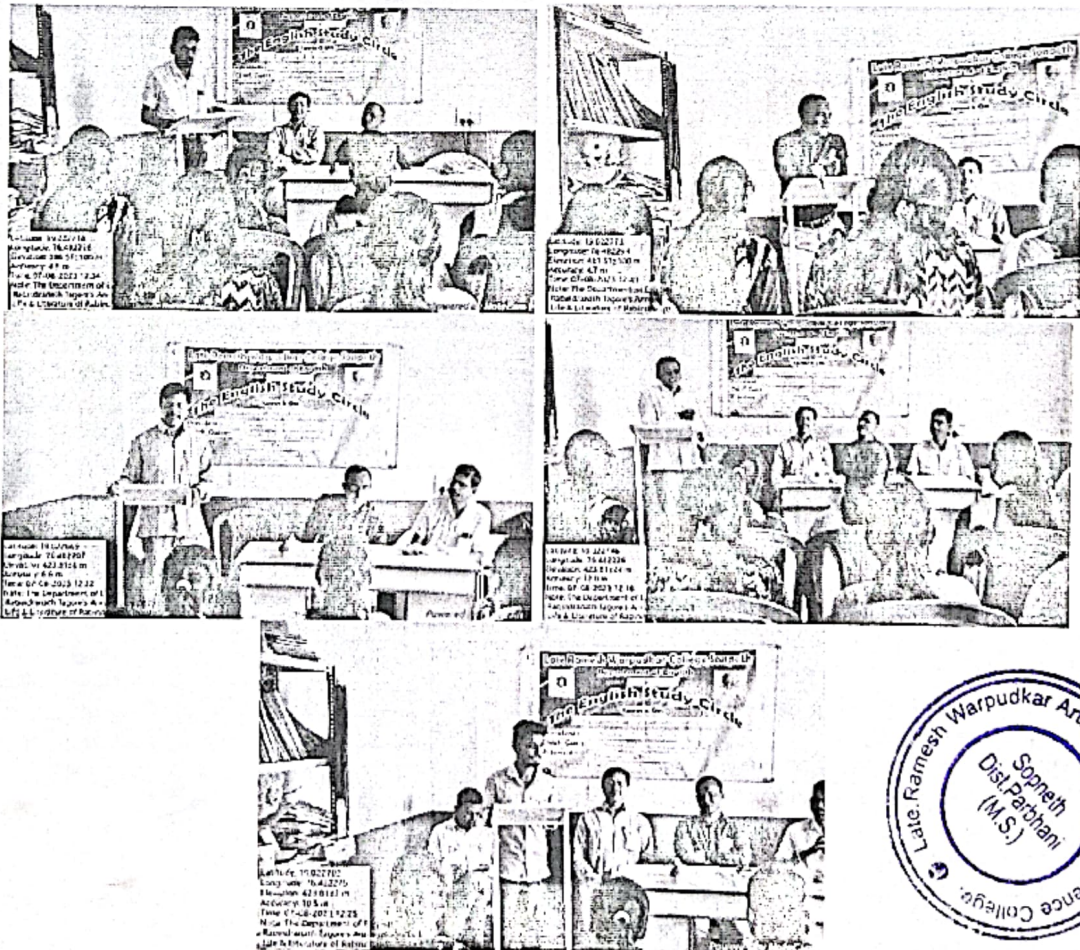

Abstract of the Programme

Rabindranath Tagore was the versatile personality from the Indian writing in English. Tagore was a Bengali polymath who was active as a poet, writer, playwright, composer, philosopher, social reformer, and painter during the age of Bengal Renaissance. He reshaped Bengali literature and music as well as Indian art with Contextual Modernism in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. Author of the "profoundly sensitive, fresh and beautiful" poetry of <i>Gitanjali</i>, he became in 1913 the first non-European and the first lyricist to win the Nobel Prize in Literature. Tagore's poetic songs were viewed as spiritual and mercurial; where his elegant prose and magical poetry were widely popular in the Indian subcontinent. He was a fellow of the Royal Asiatic Society. Referred to as "the Bard of Bengal", Tagore was known by sobriquets: Gurudev, Kobiguru, and Biswokobi.</p> <p>Principal Dr.Vasant Satpute Sir was present as the President of the programme. He also speak about the contribution of Rabindranath Tagore. He appreciated the various activities run by the department of English.
