Keeping in mind the charitable attitude, the founder President, Late Rajabau Kadam, established Hanuman Shikshan Prasak Mandal in 1993. Late Ramesh Warpudkar ACS College is the first unit of the Mandal which started in 1994.

The very objective behind establishing such unit was to bring the Ganga of higher education to a small town like Sonpeth which is backward in terms of higher education. Hanuman Shikshan Prasarak Mandal, with the motto 'Gyanat Dharma Tatah Sukham', has undertaken to provide quality higher education to the youths of Sonpeth taluka. The institution's first unit, Late Ramesh Warpudkar ACS College has recently completed twenty-five years and the progress of the college till date is destined to lead towards excellence. The present president of the organization Hon. Parameshwar Kadam Saheb started various educational units under the organization since last thirteen years. Founder President **Late Rajabau Kadam** had a dream to provide higher education to youths of Sonpeth vicinity in general and to the girls in particular. Keeping in mind the tendency of parents towards English medium in primary education, L.R.K. an English medium school was started in the name of Late Rajabau Kadam Saheb. Apart from this, a study center of Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University has been established to bring the students who have drifted away from the flow of education back into the main flow. Looking at the scarcity of the PG education in the area, the institution has begun postgraduate education M.A. & M. Com (External Mode) from the academic year 2019-20, which is affiliated to Swami Ramanand Tirtha Marathwada University Nanded.

RULES FOR MAINTAINING DISCIPLINE IN THE COLLEGE

1. Identity Card:

- After admission students will be given identity card.
- Recent passport size photo stick on admission form.
- No one is allowed to enter the College Premises without a valid Identity Card, displayed on person or a valid pass for a specific purpose.
- Within a week after taking admission, students will have to take their identity cards from office / library. Students should bring their identity card everyday to the college.
- If students lost their original identity card then application along with fees 50 rupees submitted in office.

2. Attendance :

- Each student must have attended at least 75% of the total number of the lectures and practicals conducted in the class. The student will not be eligible to appear for the Semester-end Examination if he/she fails to put in the required attendance.
- Stipulated attendances, completion of assignments, mid-term Examination are mandatory components for becoming eligible to appear for the Semester-end Examination.

3. Students should be:

- Student's necessary to follow code of conduct and discipline of class and college.
- Punctuality, sincerity and regularity should be maintained by every students
- Students should be polite and well-behaved while interacting with the teaching and non-teaching staff of the college.
- Keep silence in library and study room, in the corridors, campus while the classes are commencing.
- Student should not participate in current politics.
- Students must bebehaves as to improve quality of themselves.
- Students are requested to inform their interest in Sports, Cultural, NSS or any other to the respective incharge immediately after the completion of admission.
- It is whole responsibility of students to submit necessary documents regarding admission procedure.
- Admission taken on submitting any fake document will be cancelled immidiately and necessary action against such student will be taken as per IPC.
- Students not participate in tose activities which against Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada Vidyapeeth Nanded and Maharashtra University Act 2016.
- Students represent their demands, problems, complains etc. properly and silently in front of college authority.
- If students want to be any help firstly they approaches related Head of the Department and then to Principal.

4. Library:

- Books taken from the library will have to be return before receiveing the hall ticket.
- Students use library books, text books, reference books, newspaper, computer properly.

5. No association or society or any other body shall be formed in the college or the hostel without prior permission of the Principal.
6. Administrative notices displayed on notice board
7. No person will be invited to address or preside over any function of the college except with the approval of the Principal.
8. No student is allowed to use any mobile phone or any other electronic gadget in the classroom, library, laboratory or Audio-Visual Hall without prior permission of the concerned authority.
9. Copying in examination is a penal offence
10. LOITERING in the corridors of the College is STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
11. If any student is found smoking, drinking, taking drugs in the College, he will be summarily dismissed from the College.
12. Spitting on the Floors and staircases, throwing of waste paper in the compound as well as disfiguring the college walls and similar objectionable activities are strictly prohibited.
13. No student should mishandle the College Property / Furniture / fixtures / electrical gadgets etc.

14. During their free period, the students are allowed to go to the ground floor for recreation. Vacant Rooms, however, can be utilized for reading /writing / studying only.
15. No function or Common off or meetings of any kind, under any circumstances, anywhere in the college or outside, shall be organized except with the prior permission of the Principal and are banned in the college premises.
16. In matters of discipline, the Principal's decision will be final.
17. If students have doubt on impartial attitude about administration, teaching and related things to college then students do not take admission to this college.

18. Regarding the indiscipline of the students.:

Students should abide by the rules and regulations of the college while in the college campus. Serious action would be taken against those students, who do not follow the college disciplinary rules. Admission of such students is liable to be cancelled.

The following are considered to be indisciplinary action of the students.

- Not to bring identity cards to the college
- Impolite behaviour with the teaching and non-teaching staff.
- To chew paan, tobacco, drink alcoholic beverages
- To write or draw indecent words or obscene pictures on the walls, benches, desks or black/ white board.
- To loiter in the corridor while the classes are going on or in the college campus.
- To stand in front of the classes and disturb the class.
- To go for tours, trips, or arrange gathering without the permission of the college authority
- To tease the fellow students.
- To fight amongst and promote groupism.
- To go on common off.
- To get involved directly or indirectly in ragging activity.
- If the students misbehave with College staff and non-teaching staff then he/she can get following punishments.
- Expelled and Restricted for certain duration.
- Expelled and Restricted from college.
- 300 Rupees fine.
- Restricted from College and University Examination for 5 years.
- Result will be cancelled.
- Bad remark on T.C

RULES OF ADMISSION

1. Without registration admission will not be given
2. Selected candidates list for admission displayed on notice board
3. Admission on merit basis.
4. Admission form with prospectus available in office.
5. Students read carefully information brochure and registration form then fill correctly and submit with their original documents along with attested photo copies.
6. After closing registration within three days merit list will be displayed on notice board.
7. Students will not give their any documents, original or photo copies not return in any circumstances.

8. Once Students select their stream and subject will not be changed again any circumstances.
9. Reserve candidate should be admitted according to rule.
10. Students should submit their admission and other forms themselves or their guardians.
11. Principal will be rejected admission without any reason.
12. If students want to cancel their admission they have compulsion to paid full fees.
13. If students want Duplicate TC or other documents before that they will submit their lost information by producing advertisement in reputed newspaper or F.I.R. of related police station.
14. The Students who wish to seek admission in different courses should submit original certificate of following along with three true copies at the time of admission.
 - i. H.S.C. Marks Memo
 - ii. Transfer Certificate (TC)
 - iii. Recent Passport size Photograph. (Two copies)
 - iv. Students belongs to SC/ST/DNT/NT/VJNT/OBC/SBC (Except OPEN) should submit the caste certificate and caste validity certificate.
 - v. E.B.C. application form along with income certificate. (Tehsil)
 - vi. Self attested ADHAR and VOTER ID.
 - vii. Tehsil Domacil
 - viii. Granted Scholarship Number
 - ix. Other district students submit District transfer certificate.
 - x. Other university students submit migration certificate.
 - xi. For first year students must fill eligibility certificate
 - xii. If discontinuity in education, gap certificate must be attached.
 - xiii. Immediate submits E.B.C., Scholarship and related documents after admission.

CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION.

1. If students want to cancel their admission they have compulsion to paid full fees.
2. Students will not give their any documents, original or photo copies not return in any circumstances before cancellation of admission.
3. Before applying for a migration certificate or a transfer certificate students must clear all dues outstanding in their name on account of College Like

4. Transference Certificate- an application for Transference certificate must be submitted through the Principal of the College to which the student wishes to be transferred.
5. Migration Certificate – Students migrating to other Universities should note the following procedure for securing a migration certificate.

ANTI-RAGGING CELL

Ragging is legally banned. It is a punishable offence. In view of the increasing number of events of ragging, the University Grants Commission has passed the "UGC Regulation on Curbing the Menace of Ragging In Higher Educational Institutions, 2009." Ragging is any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudness a fresher or any other students or includind in rowdy or in-disciplined activity by any students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance , hardship or psychological harm or to raisr fear or apprrehension thereof in any fresher or any other student or asking any student to do any act which such student will not in any ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student, with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing of power , authority of superiority by a student over any fresher or any other students.

The Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishment namely.

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Withholding / withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process.
- Withholding results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national, international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- Suspension / expulsion from the hostel
- Cancellation of admission.
- Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semester.
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specific period.
- Provided that where the person committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.
- The students are advised to consult the Anti-Ragging Committee in case of emergency.
- Note: Students will have to submit the ANNEXURE-I (Affidavit by the students) and ANNEXURE-II (Affidavit by the parents/ Guardian at the time of admission.

VARIOUS ACTIVITIES OF COLLEGE

SUPPORTING SERVICES

- **Students Council:** It is constituted as per Maharashtra University Act 1994, section 40 and it runs activities for the welfare of the students.
- **Cultural and Sports:** The College forms cultural and sports committee with teachers interested in these activities, so that they motivate the students to actively participate in these activities.

For the active participation of students in sports and games, the college gives incentives to the participants like offering nutritious meals, track suits, shoes, TA/DA, sports scholarship, and other incentives. The college rewards the students with cash prizes, awards, certificates and mementos.

- **Avishkar Research Festival:** To develop research attitude in the students, Research festival is organized. Best entries are sent for university level research festival. All encouragement is given to the students to use computers during presentation and participation in seminar.
- **N.S.S.:** NSS activities to nurture the talents of students and develop leadership qualities in them. NSS unit acts as a bridge between college and the society and is operating since the opening of this college. The college unit has rendered its assistance in holding blood donation camps, helping in maintenance of Law and order in the city. Creating awareness against female infanticide and AIDS.
- **Seminars:** In order to develop communication skill, seminar are held in each subject for all subjects. Seminar are also form of part of curriculum. This practice help in developing stage courage, research paper writing, presentation skill and communication skill among students.
- **Science Association:** Under this activity, efforts are made to develop scientific temperament among the students. The student member of science association celebrate various scientific events including birth anniversaries of different scientists. National Science Day, guest lecture of eminent speakers are arranged. The science Exhibition also arranged by department of Chemistry and Botany.
- **Alumni Association:** The college has a registered alumni association. Member of the association offer valuable suggestions for development of college and also have contributed by providing finance to development of college.
- **Study tour and Industrial Visit:** Study tour are an important curricula of different subjects. Accordingly, study tour are arranged every year and the students are taken to various renowned institutions and are acquainted with different techniques. The industrial visits help in understanding the requirement of industries and accordingly the students can prepare themselves.
- **Seminar, Workshop and Conferences:** The college organize seminar, workshop and conference at national level in various subjects. These conferences and workshops are funded by many funding agencies. In such conferences, the staff and students can interact with eminent researchers and have exchange of ideas.
- **Research Activity:** The college has encouraging research ambience. The faculty is recipient of minor and major research projects. Presently 4 minor projects are ongoing of the total staff. There are 17 Ph.D. holders and 10 are research guides. The research facilities are provided to research guides and research students from other institutes also. Presently about 10 students are doing research. The faculty and research students are encouraged to present their research findings in seminars and conferences and publishing the research papers in reputed research journals.

- **Student's prizes:** In order to provide encouragement, the meritorious students at different levels are given prizes. These prizes are sponsored by faculty members of this college in the memory of their beloved ones.
- **Student Aid Forum:** In order to solve difficulties of students who are economically poor but are bright scholars in their academic pursuit, like medical aid, availability of books & stationary

,accommodation, payment of various fees, the college has consulted Students Accommodation Facility. (SAF)

- **Adoption of students by teacher:** In order to help economically very poor but intelligent students, some of the teaching staff adopt one or two students in a year & support them financially till the completion of the course in the campus.
- **Teacher's evaluation by the students:** Final year students give their feedback responses on individual teachers in written form every year. This is to understand the strength & weakness of the teaching faculty from the stakeholder directly.
- **A general surveillance:** The surveillance with installed infrared cameras is carried out in the library, science laboratory, classrooms, office and campus of the college and monitoring is done by the principal itself to ensure safety & security of the students.

FACILITIES OFFERED TO STUDENTS

- Fully computerized **language laboratory** to promote English environment and provide ear training exercises in English language and thereby develop communication skills in English to meet the global challenges with confidence.
- **ICT awareness:** The college has 20 computers with internet services on the campus. The students are free to use computer and internet facility all round the clock on the campus.
- **Internet Centre:** An internet facility free of charge is provided to students. The students utilize the facility for collecting study material.
- **Library:** The College has a big library. The library has a collection of many rare books, periodicals are available. Library provides the all types of regional as well as national newspaper to the students and faculty. The researchers are provided a facility of back volumes. The library has 7200 books, ---unique titles of arts and related disciplines. In addition, biographies of great person, competitive exam books, journals are available. Library is fully automated. Online Public Access (OPAC) facility is provided to users. Library is a registered member of INFLIBNET, Ahmedabad, for the subscription of N-list, online access facility, under this user can have access to 6000 research based journals and 31,35,000 e-books.
- **Project oriented,** task based teaching supplemented by field visits / study tours / visit to industry.
- **E- Learning Centre** with video conferencing facility.
- The college has Committee for Women Empowerment, Women Grievance Cell and Sexual Harassment Cell. The member could be approached by any girl's students with any personal or gender related problem for all help. The institution is free from sexual harassment of women students on the campus and there is a harmonious relation between girls and boys. The college is also free from ragging.
- **Women's Hostel:** The College has completed construction of Women's Hostel having accommodation of 21 girl students.
- **Grievance and Redressal:** The cell considers the grievances of the students either through oral or written or suggestion box. The committee discusses the grievances of the students and redresses them by taking necessary steps. The committee informs the students concerned regarding the redressal. The institution has suggestion boxes to receive the complaints and suggestions. These

are collected by the members of IQAC and discussed along with Principal. Necessary steps are taken to resolve the complaints and are communicated to the applicant.

- **Railway and bus concessions:** The Students should note that grant of Bus concession facility is not the responsibility of College authorities. However, in order to promote and protect the interests of students, who come from long distances, the College will make necessary arrangements to enable the students to get bus concession facility by concerned authorities. The actual grant of bus concession facility will depend upon the supply of railway concession forms from Bus Authorities. The students must also comply with rules and the procedures prescribed by Bus Authorities from time to time; failing which they may not be granted the Bus concession facility. The co-operation of Bus transport authorities and students is highly essential for the grant of concessions.

- **Best Teacher and Best Student of the year:** The institutional authority decide to encouraging the students along with faculty member of the college, for this reason College will gave Best Teacher and Best Student of the year Award. These awards are announced on the first day of annual gathering programme.

Linkages have been developed and MoU's have been signed with institute of national repute. Department Library MoU's have been signed with reputed institute from this state.
- An active and strong **educational management** that is ever encouraging and supporting the faculty, students, and the college staff in all its academic and administrative ventures.
- Complete transparency is maintained in admission of the students, recruitment of the faculty, staff, administration.
- **Mahila Suraksha & Sudhar Samiti** organizes various programmes and lecture for girls students and thereby bring awareness among them regarding the social, political, cultural, gender based problems of the contemporary society.
- The college always encourages the students to expres themselves through wallpapers from all departments.
- The college publishes the **college magazine "PRADNYA"** annually which features articles, poems, thoughts and lyrics written by the students in English, Marathi, and Hindi. It also has all the academic, cultural, sports, co-curricular details of the college during academic year.
