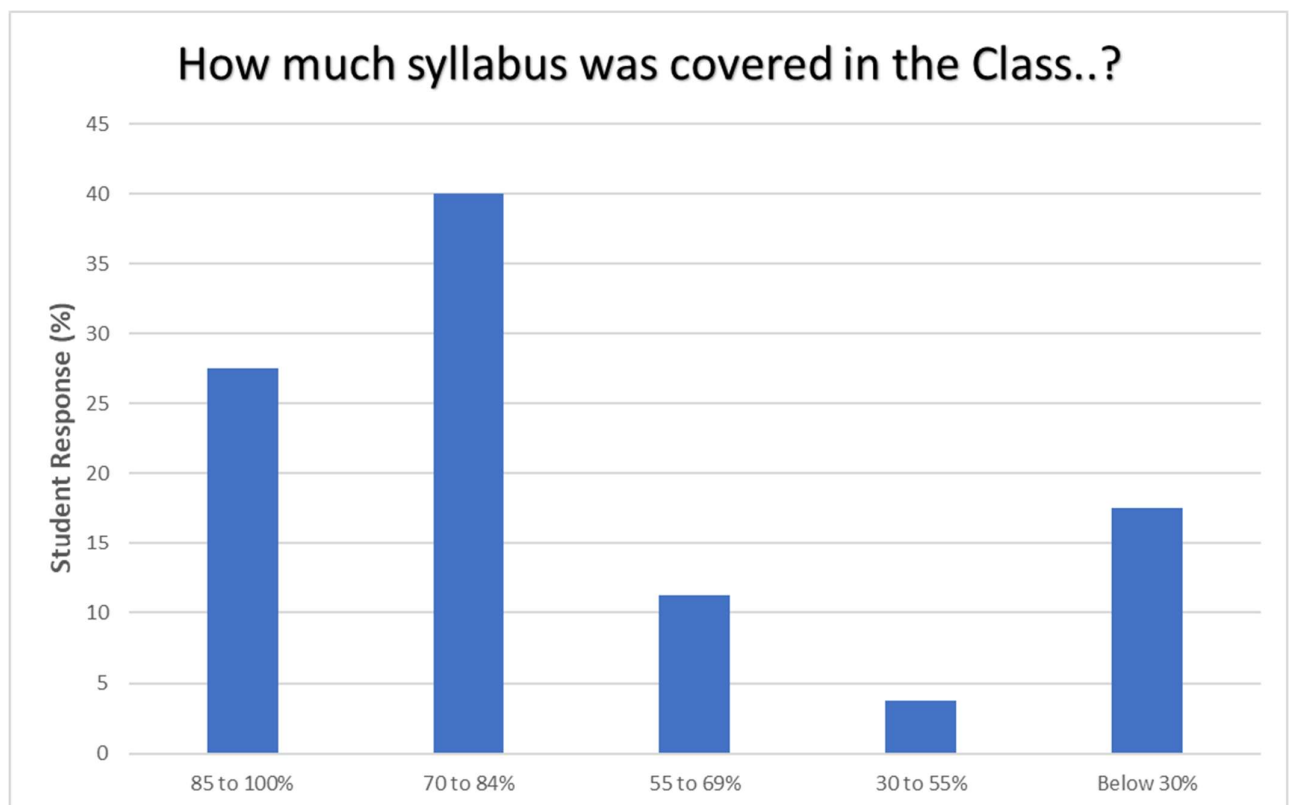
ANALYSIS OF STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY 2023-24
